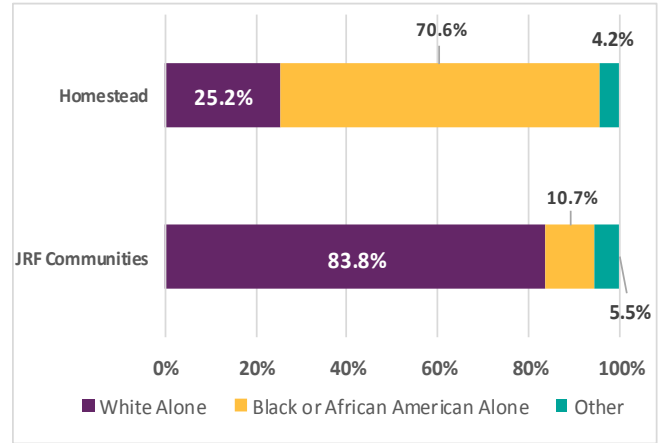

Population: 3,157

Population by Race/Ethnicity:

- As of 2014, Homestead’s total population was estimated at 3,157.
- The racial/ethnic composition of Brentwood is 25.2% white, 70.6% African American and 4.2% other races.
- 17% of the total population is over age 65 — lower than the JRF Communities (18%) and higher than the City of Pittsburgh. Homestead residents between the ages of 18–64 make up 58% of the population. Children under age 18 account for 25% of the population.
- The median age for Homestead is 38.5. This is lower than Allegheny County (41) and higher than the city of Pittsburgh (33).



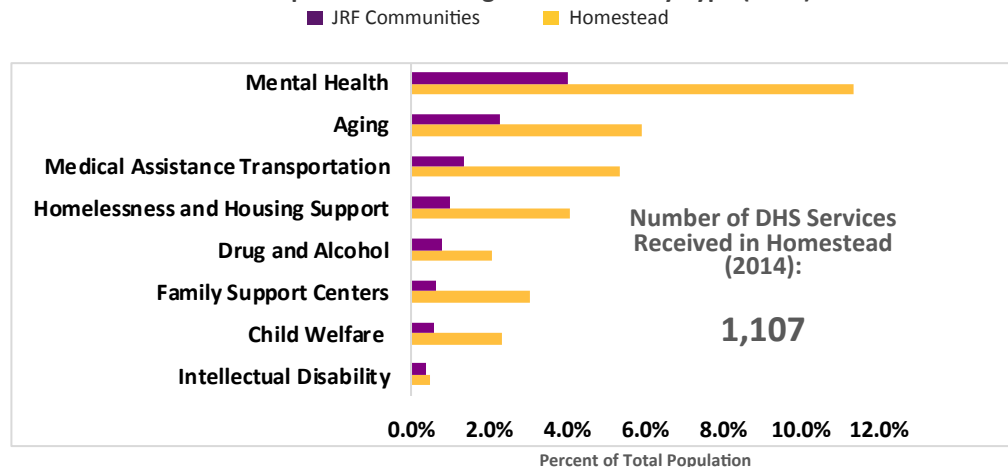

- In 2014, 959 residents of Homestead (30% of the total population) received SNAP benefits.

Allegheny County Department of Human Services (DHS) provides human services to Allegheny County residents, including emergency help and support for long term needs. Below is break down of services provided by DHS by percent of total population. Homestead is compared with the JRF Communities. Aging and Mental Health Services were the most utilized for both— though Homestead had a higher percent of the population (11.4%) utilizing Mental Health services.
