## TOP THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT VOTING

- 1 Who can vote?** (1) Individuals who have been citizens for at least 1 month, (2) Individuals 18 years or older who have been a resident of PA and the district at least 30 days prior to the election, (3) Some individuals with a criminal status or history may qualify to vote. Refer to [vote.pa.gov](http://vote.pa.gov) for more information on these criteria.
- 2 Register to vote!** Voter registration takes 5 minutes and can be done online at [vote.pa.gov](http://vote.pa.gov), in person at the Allegheny County election offices or through the mail.
- 3 Know your candidate.** Visit the candidate's website for their political positions. Campaign finance information and past voting records are available to the public. [Campaign finance information](#) and [past voting records](#) are available to the public.
- 4 Voting is secure and easy.** There are several safeguards to making voting accessible and secure: new voting systems, post-election audits, layered set of protections, strategic data sharing, collaboration and communication, ongoing training.
