TOP THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT VOTING

Who can vote?

- 1
- 1) Individuals who have been citizens for at least 1 month
- 2) Individuals 18 years or older who have been a resident of PA and the district at least 30 days prior to the election
- 3) Some individuals with a criminal status or history may qualify to vote. Refer to <u>vote.pa.gov</u> for more information on these criteria.
- Register to vote! Voter registration takes 5 minutes and can be done online at <u>vote.pa.gov</u>, in person at the Allegheny County election offices or through the mail.
- Know your candidate. Visit the candidate's website for their political positions. <u>Campaign finance information</u> and <u>past voting records</u> are available to the public.
- To make voting accessible and secure in Pennsylvania. There are several safeguards to making voting accessible and secure: new voting systems, post-election audits, layered set of protections, strategic data sharing, collaboration and communication, ongoing training.
