1. **Community Impact:** Tangible outcomes or improvements in health or well-being within the JRF service area.
2. **Collaboration Highlight:** Depth, effectiveness, and meaningful coordination between partner organizations.
3. **Community Voice:** Evidence that community input, engagement, or feedback was actively incorporated into the initiative.
4. **Accessibility & Inclusion:** Thoughtful consideration of accessibility and inclusion to ensure equitable participation.
