Responding to SNAP Payment Delays in SWPA

What to do NOW:

- Prepare + share a list of resources: food distributions, pantries, and other organizations providing free food
- Volunteer and/or donate to local food resources if you can
- Call on Congress to urge USDA to use contingency funds to mitigate harm, and end the government shutdown by passing a budget that protects healthcare.
